TITLE: 911 Emergency Communications Recorder Replacement

BACKGROUND:

Emergency Communications seeks approval to use \$110,407 to purchase a new recorder at the primary 911 communications center. The new recorder has the ability to record multiple lines (from different core systems) at one time reducing the likelihood of calls failing to record. The funds to cover the cost of the recorder come from two places -- contract savings with Motorola of \$65,407, and leftover funds remaining from the Radio Project totaling \$45,000. No additional county funds are required to purchase the new recorder. A copy of the change order is attached for your review.

RECOMMENDATION(S):

Staff recommends approval for Emergency Communications to purchase a new primary site recorder that has multi-line recording capabilities. In addition, to properly allocate for the purchase of the recorder, staff requests the transfer of \$45,000 from the Capital Projects/Site Development account (327-7552-423.77-10) to the Capital Projects/Equipment-Radios/Mobiles account (327-7552-423.78-16). Between the remaining project funds and contract savings the recorder purchase can be made without additional county funds.
