

**Petition to the Fannin County Commissioners Court**

**Subject: Installation of posted speed limit sign(s) along CR 1520**

**WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, HEREBY PETITION** the Fannin County Commissioners Court to approve the implementation of a 30 MPH speed limit on County Road 1520.

**WE STATE OR BELIEVE:**

1. That the petitioners are adult residents of CR 1520, Fannin County, TX.
2. That vehicles travel at excessive speeds on a daily basis creating dangerous conditions to nearby residents who share the road while walking, jogging or other forms of exercise. As more families move into the nearby housing developments over the next year, this problem will only get worse.
3. That a speed limit of 30 MPH is a safe and reasonable speed for this 3 mile stretch of road.
4. That the installation of posted speed limit signs near the following intersections is the most cost-effective measure to address this problem:
