RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT TO J&W ASPHALT, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$930,000 FOR INFRARED REPAIR SERVICES AT VARIOUS MINNEAPOLIS PARK AND RECREATION BOARD PROPERTIES FOR THE YEARS 2023-2026, BID EVENT MPLMN #2305, WITHIN THE REGIONAL PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROGRAM

Whereas, The Minneapolis Park & Recreation Board (MPRB) is the steward of Minneapolis park system;

Whereas, The MPRB is authorized to contract with public and private entities in the performance of its functions;

Whereas, The MPRB publicly solicited and received two (2) bids on March 16, 2024, per Bid Event MPLMN #2305, Infrared Repair Services at various Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board Properties for the years 2023-2026;

Whereas, All bids have been reviewed and tabulated with the low bid being submitted by J&W Asphalt, Inc., in the amount of \$930,000.00, for its base bid;

Whereas, MPRB staff have reviewed the bid offered by J&W Asphalt, Inc., and find it to be complete and correct and support an award of a contract for Infrared Repair Services at various Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board Properties for the years 2023-2026;

Whereas, This bid offered by J&W Asphalt, Inc., has been reviewed and approved by the Minneapolis Purchasing and Procurement Departments and Civil Rights;

Whereas, The Regional Pavement Rehabilitation program includes is funding O&M Lottery Proceeds;

Whereas, The funding in the program is available to be spent on regional trail rehabilitation and sufficient to cover all project costs; and

Whereas, This resolution is supported by Parks for All, the MPRB Comprehensive Plan 2021-2036, which sets the goal (s) 02. "Steward a continuum of nature and recreation" and 03. "Provide core services with care;"

BACKGROUND

This Board action considers a contract with J&W Asphalt, Inc., in the amount of \$930,000.00 for Infrared Repair Services, Bid Event MPLMN #2305 at various Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board Properties for the years 2023-2026, Bid Event MPLMN #2305, from O&M Lottery-in-Lieu Proceeds in the Regional Pavement Rehabilitation program.

On March 16, 2023 the Minneapolis Park & Recreation Board publicly solicited bids (*Attachment A*) and received two bids for Infrared Repair Services at Various Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board Park properties for the years 2023-2026. The low bid was submitted by J&W Asphalt, Inc. (*Attachment B*). This resolution accepts the low base bid as submitted by J&W Asphalt, Inc., for a total contract amount of \$930,000.00.
