SUBJECT: Receive information and provide direction to Administrative Services on selection of security guard professional services. (Ten minute estimate)

Recommendation

Receive information and provide direction to Administrative Services on selection of security guard professional services.

Background:

This item was previously brought to the Board on October 27, 2020. Administrative Services was seeking direction from the Board on how to proceed and staff presented the Board option A and option B.

Option A extends the existing contract to January 31, 2022 with Elite Universal Security with a new hourly rate of \$20.06 and option B selects Pride Asset Protection's proposal for a new three-year contract with two one-year options at an hourly rate of \$19.10 with a potential cost savings of approximately \$187,000.00 for the term of the contract.

The Chairman was absent from the Board meeting and two Board members voted for option A and two voted for option B. As a result of the voting no option was approved by majority vote. Board members requested that this be heard again at the next Board meeting and would like know if there were any complaints against Elite Universal Security.

Discussion:

There have been some complaints brought to Elite Universal Security supervisors and directly to the security guards and they have been addressed. Elite Universal Security has been very responsive to our complaints.

Administrative Services requests direction from the Board of Supervisors on how to proceed.

Option A: Extend the existing contract with Elite Universal Security. The Board would reject all the proposals in the recent RFP and direct Administrative Services to extend the existing contract with Elite Universal Security to January 31, 2022.

Option B: Select the top ranked proposal from the recent RFP; Pride Asset Protection. The Board would direct Administrative Services to prepare a contract with Pride Asset Protection and not authorize Administrative Services to exercise the option to extend the existing contract.

Committee Action:

This item is being brought directly to the Board since it was previously heard by the Board.

Fiscal Impact:

There is a fiscal impact based on the option chosen as outlined in the staff report.
