Recommendation

Administrative Services staff recommends the Board of Supervisors approve the Resolution to support Operation Green Light declaring the week of November 7th through Veterans Day, November 13th, 2022, a time to salute and honor the service of our men and women who served in the armed forces.

Background/Discussion

The National Association of Counties (NACo) and the National Association of County Veteran Service Officers (NACVSO) are inviting the nation's 3,069 counties, parishes and boroughs to join Operation Green Light and show support for veterans by lighting our buildings green during the week of Veterans Day, November 7 to November 13.

Yuba County appreciates the sacrifices of our United State Military Personnel and would like to participate in the special recognition of Operation Green Light and encourage its citizens to recognize the importance of honoring all those who made the immeasurable sacrifices by displaying a green light in a window of their place of business or residence.
