

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT
BY AND BETWEEN COUNTY OF YUBA AND
MICHAEL CICOZZI**

This FIRST AMENDMENT (the "First Amendment") is made and entered into as of this ____ Day of October 2022 by and between Yuba County (Employer) and Michael Ciccozzi (Employee); herein after referred to as Employer and Employee individually as a party and collectively as the "parties".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Employer and Employee entered into the Employment Agreement with an effective date of March 11, 2019 for a period of four years.

WHEREAS, Employer and Employee now desire to amend the agreement, including the terms and conditions thereof, to include extension of the termination date; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and obligations herein contained, and other goods and valuable consideration the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

AGREEMENT

1. RECITALS INCORPORATED. The above recitals are true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein by this reference as if fully set forth as part of the First Amendment.
2. RECITALS SECTION A shall be amended to read; County desires to employ as County Counsel and employee desires to serve as the County Counsel for the County Beginning March 11, 2019 through July 31, 2023.
3. AGREEMENT SECTION 2 Duties (b) shall be amended to read; Employee shall perform his duties to the best of his ability in accordance with the highest professional and ethical standards of the profession and shall comply with all general rules and regulations established by County. Employee shall at all times during the term of this Agreement be an attorney licensed to practice law and a member in good standing of the State Bar of California.
4. AGREEMENT SECTION 3 Term (a) shall be amended to read; The term of this Agreement shall be from the date first set forth above in Recital A until terminated by either party in accordance with provisions hereinafter set forth or unless terminated in the event of death, incapacity, permanent disability or suspension or disbarment of Employee from the State Bar of California.
5. ALL OTHER TERMS. All other sections, parts, terms and conditions of the agreement not expressly amended by this First Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.


