**SUBJECT:** Approve Amendment 1 to the professional services agreement between Yuba County and NV5 for quality assurance services, and authorize Chair to execute

### *Recommendation*

Administrative Services' staff recommends the Board of Supervisors approve the professional services agreement between Yuba County Administrative Services and NV5 for quality assurance testing services for the Tri-County Juvenile Rehabilitation Facility Project, and authorize Chair to execute.

### *Background:*

Yuba County has been awarded funding from Senate Bill 81 (SB81) for the Tri-County Juvenile Rehabilitation Facility (TCJRF). The project is located at 938 14<sup>th</sup> Street in Marysville. The project consists of 32 beds, program space, medical and therapy room, day rooms, administration offices, medical office, lobby, laundry room and recreation yards. The construction of the TCJRF requires quality assurance testing services.

### *Discussion:*

NV5 has performed work for Yuba County on multiple projects, including the TCJRF. The TCJRF started construction in February 2021 and NV5 has been providing the quality assurance testing. The project was delayed due to the State Fire Marshall, which extended the project completion timeline. The estimated completion date is June 2023. This amendment will extend the contract with NV5 and provide the quality assurance testing services that are required to the completion of the project.

Administrative Services recommends the Board approve the first amendment to the professional services agreement with NV5 for quality assurance testing services and authorize the Chair to execute.

The total estimated cost of the proposed project is \$21,440,843. State SB1 will fund \$15,255,741. The remaining \$6,185,102 will be split 40% each \$2,474,041 by Yuba County and \$2,474,041 by Sutter County, and 20% \$1,237,020 by Colusa County. The \$200,000 for quality assurance testing is included in the total cost of the project.
