Recommendation

The department of Public Works recommends that the Board of Supervisors approve plans, specifications, estimate and authorize advertisement for bid for the Cedar Lane Safe Routes to School Improvements Project.

Background

The Safe Routes to School Program is a state-funded program that is part of the Active Transportation Program. The Safe Routes to School Program purpose is to increase safety for biking and walking to schools and incentivize these modes of transportation. Disadvantaged communities are prioritized for improvements and benefits from the program. Yuba County was programmed \$2,729,000 in State only ATP funds for infrastructure construction of the Cedar Lane Safe Routes to School Improvements Project.

Discussion

The proposed project will rehabilitate and improve approximately 0.60 mile of roadways including Cedar Lane (entire length) and Alicia Ave between Feather River Boulevard and Riverside Avenue, in West Linda. Improvements will include new curbs, gutters, sidewalks, bike lanes, crosswalks, striping, and ADA compliant curb ramps. The engineer's estimate for construction and construction engineering is \$3,500,000.00. The project is expected to be completed by December 2023.

Committee Action:

This item is being presented to the full Board of Supervisors as it is included in the approved County budget.

Fiscal Impact:

No funding commitment at this time but has projected future costs. Once the project is bid, the department will come back to the Board of Supervisors for contract authorization. This project has an estimated cost of \$3,500,000.
