Recommendation

The department of Public Works recommends that the Board of Supervisors approve plans, specifications, estimate and authorize advertisement for bid for the Spring Valley Road over Dry Creek Bridge Replacement Project.

Background

The Highway Bridge Program (HBP) is a federally-funded program that is funded through the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). The Highway Bridge Program purpose is to rehabilitate and replace public highway bridges over waterways, other topographical barriers, other highways, or railroads when the State and the Federal Highway Administration determine that a bridge qualifies under the HBP Program Guidelines.

Discussion

The proposed project will replace the existing bridge on Spring Valley Rd over Dry Creek in Browns Valley, CA. Improvements will include a new bridge and roadway approaches. The engineer's estimate for construction and construction engineering is \$3,300,000.00. The project is expected to be completed by February 2024.

Committee Action:

This item is being presented directly to the full Board of Supervisors as it is contained in the approved County budget.

Fiscal Impact

No funding commitment at this time but has projected future costs. Once the project is bid, the department will come back to the Board of Supervisors for contract award. This project has a projected cost of \$3,300,000.00, which is 100% reimbursable through the HBP program.
