SUBJECT: Community Development and Services: Approve Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Marysville Joint Unified School District for the Cedar Lane Elementary School Improvements and authorize chair to execute.

Recommendation

The department of Public Works recommends that the Board of Supervisors approve the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Marysville Joint Unified School District (MJUSD) for the Cedar Lane Safe Routes to School Improvements Project.

Background

The Safe Routes to School Program is a state-funded program that is part of the Active Transportation Program. The Safe Routes to School Program purpose is to increase safety for biking and walking to schools and incentivize these modes of transportation. Disadvantaged communities are prioritized for improvements and benefits from the program. Yuba County was programmed \$2,729,000 in State only ATP funds for infrastructure construction of the Cedar Lane Safe Routes to School Improvements Project.

MJUSD has requested a concrete walkway to be constructed as part of the project along the frontage of Cedar Lane Elementary School. MJUSD will reimburse the County for the cost of the improvements and dedicate right of way easements for the project.

Discussion

The proposed MOU will permit the County to construct improvements on behalf of MJUSD and also provide the right of way needed by dedication to construct the Cedar Lane Safe Routes to School Improvements Project. Improvements will include removal of an existing fence, construction of a

concrete walkway, and reconfiguration of the irrigation adjacent to the walkway. The engineer's estimate for construction of the improvements is \$70,000. MJUSD will reimburse the County for the construction costs. The project is expected to be completed by December 2023.

Committee Action:

Due to the routine nature of the item and since the project is in the approved County budget, this item is being presented directly to the full Board of Supervisors.

Fiscal Impact:

No funding commitment, administrative only, staff time only. All costs associated with the MOU are to be reimbursed by MJUSD.
