Recommendation:

Approve the agreement between the Sheriff's Department and U. S. Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration to provide law enforcement services relating to the eradication and suppression of illicit marijuana, and authorize Chair to sign.

Background:

This is an annual agreement which has been in effect for many years and requires Board of Supervisor's approval to provide law enforcement services for the eradication of illicit cannabis plants and in the investigation and prosecution of these cases. The agreement covers the period of October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023, and provides funding in the amount of \$25,000.

Discussion:

This is the continuation of an agreement that is a benefit to both the Sheriff's Department and the Drug Enforcement Administration. The agreement will provide a total of \$25,000 in additional law enforcement revenue. The Sheriff will provide law enforcement personnel in accordance with the attached agreement.
