SUBJECT: Approve amendment 1 with 3QC, Inc., for Commissioning Authority Services for the Medical and Mental Health Facility, and authorize Chair to execute.

Recommendation:

Administrative Services' staff recommends the Board of Supervisors approve amendment 1 to the professional services agreement between Yuba County and 3QC, Inc., for commissioning authority services for the Medical and Mental Health Facility, and authorize Chair to execute.

Background & Discussion:

Yuba County has been awarded funding from Senate Bill 863 (SB863) for the Medical and Mental Health Facility. The project is located at 215 5th Street in Marysville. The medical and mental health facility will include medical exam/treatment, radiology and dental clinic, interview, group treatment spaces, classroom/vocational space, office and administrative areas, lobby, and a laundry room.

Administrative Services went out to Request for Proposals for Commissioning Authority Services for the Medical and Mental Health Facility in February 2021. The vendor, 3QC, Inc., was selected and awarded the contract. Due to construction delays, the contract will need to be extended. This amendment will extend the term of the contract to completion of the project.

Administrative Services recommends the Board approve the amendment and authorize the Chair to execute.
