SUBJECT: Community Development and Services: Approve agreement with R&F Engineering for Star Bend Boat Ramp Sediment Removal Project, and authorize Chair to execute.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends the Board of Supervisors award the Star Bend Boat Ramp Sediment Removal Project to R&F Engineering, and authorize the Chair to execute the contract.

BACKGROUND:

Public Works has been tasked with dredging the Star Bend Boat Ramp to restore safe ingress and egress of watercraft from the Feather River. This service is to be contracted to an outside vendor. Public Works has taken a sole source approach for this service. R&F Engineering was chosen to provide these services for the County.

DISCUSSION:

Due to time constraints and limited resources, Public Works has chosen to use R&F Engineering due to their intimate knowledge of the requirements of this project and readiness to begin the work necessary to complete this project within the funding window. They have the manpower, experience and licensing required to successfully complete this work. R&F Engineering recently completed a similar project for Sutter Butte Flood Control Agency (SBFCA) and is intimately familiar with the County's project and site. As well, due to environmental constraints, if the project is not started immediately, the construction window for summer of 2024 will be missed. This service agreement will allow for 3 years of Professional Environmental, Design, and Construction services. Design will be complete in fiscal year 23/24 and construction support will occur the remaining two construction years.

COMMITTEE ACTION:

The Land Use & Public Works Committee was bypassed, as this project is included in the approved Public Works Budget.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total of obligation is \$218,445.00 over a three year contract. Funding is currently included in the Board approved FY 22/23 Public Works budget. The majority of funds will be expended in FY 23/34, but will continue in additional fiscal years to support construction. Appropriate funding apportionments will be included in forthcoming proposed County budgets.
