SUBJECT: Community Development and Services: Award Contract No. 2023-9210 to Lamon Construction Co., Inc., for 2023 Overlay Project

Recommendation

Public Works is recommending that the Board of Supervisors approve the contract award for the project mentioned above to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder and authorize the Chair to execute the contract pending approval by County Counsel and Risk Management.

Background

In 2017, the California legislature passed SB 1, a landmark comprehensive transportation-funding bill. Through SB 1, the County will realize a sizeable amount of additional gas tax revenues for the foreseeable future. These revenues started at an additional \$940,000 in FY 17/18 and will ramp up to an additional \$4.9 million in FY 26/27. With these additional revenues, the Public Works Department began ramping up a significant road overlay/rehabilitation program beginning in the summer of 2018. As we advance, we anticipate making a major overlay contract such as this one each summer. The proposed project includes rehabilitating approximately 7.6 miles of roads, estimated at \$3,947,000.00 million. In particular, the work consists of performing dig-outs, intersection widening, cement treating roadway sub-grade, placing pavement fabric and a hot mix asphalt overlay, adjusting iron, striping, and placing shoulder backing on the following roads:

Arboga Rd – Plumas Arboga Rd to Maplehurst Rd (0.87 miles)
Arboga Rd (D) – Erle Rd to McGowan Pkwy (2.52 miles)
Avocet Dr – Entire Length (0.20 miles)
Dye Rd – Entire Length (0.55 miles)
Eagle Lane – Entire Length (0.14 miles)
Fairway Dr – Entire Length (0.18 miles)

La Porte Rd – Willow Glen to Aero Way (0.89 miles)
 Plumas Arboga Rd – Arboga Rd to Feather River BLVD (1 mile)
 Skyway Drive – Entire Length (1.25 miles)

Plumas Arboga Road and Arboga Road are within County Service Areas and will be funded with CSA 66 revenues. These two roads were included in the project to garner economy of scale for the proposed improvements.

Discussion

On April 26, 2023, staff opened bids for the subject project. The bids received are as shown below:
