**WHEREAS**, homelessness is an urgent humanitarian crisis with an estimated 172,000 unsheltered individuals across California; and

**WHEREAS**, the undertow of massive economic and systemic inequities, as well as a tangled web of policies and programs built over decades, continues to stymie efforts to support those who are unhoused or at risk of becoming unhoused; and

**WHEREAS**, California lacks a comprehensive plan to address those who are unhoused and at-risk of becoming unhoused effectively and equitably; and

**WHEREAS**, the current approach to addressing homelessness is fragmented and lacks clear lines of responsibility, accountability and sustainability; and

**WHEREAS**, to make meaningful progress in helping those who are unhoused and housing insecure, the California State Association of Counties (CSAC) offers a comprehensive approach to address homelessness; and

**WHEREAS**, the AT HOME plan includes detailed goals and specific policy proposals to ensure clear lines of responsibility and accountability for every level of government and aims to improve the way California collectively responds to those who are unhoused or at risk of becoming unhoused; and

**WHEREAS**, the six pillars of AT HOME stand for Accountability, Transparency, Housing, Outreach, Mitigation, and Economic opportunity; and

**WHEREAS**, AT HOME elevates homelessness as an important shared California priority; and

**WHEREAS**, AT HOME provides a comprehensive roadmap to reducing and mitigating homelessness; and

**WHEREAS**, counties run or administer most health and human services programs on behalf of the state and federal government; and

**WHEREAS**, California’s counties are at the frontlines of these crucial safety net programs.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the County of Yuba supports the CSAC AT HOME Plan; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County of Yuba will join a growing coalition of local government, public safety, social justice, health, labor, housing, community, and other organizations throughout the state in support of AT HOME.


