## *Recommendation*

Consider support of Call to Action from Marysville Joint Unified School District, pledging the collective efforts of community partners to coordinate actions regarding mental health and wellness in schools and the community.

## *Background/Discussion*

Marysville Joint Unified School District (MJUSD) is working to address issues in their schools that are detracting from their core mission to educate their students. In particular they are seeing an increase in disruptive behaviors and student discipline and they have created the attached "Call to Action" to describe the issue and request partners in the community to support efforts to address the issue.

Due to the language "pledge their collective efforts to coordinate actions" in the Call to Action document, it was advised by Counsel that the Board take up consideration of whether to sign onto the "pledge" as opposed to individual Board Members. If the Board wants to support the MJUSD Call to Action document it is recommended that the Board do so by authorizing the Chair to sign on behalf of the Board of Supervisors.
