**SUBJECT:** Approve Memorandum of Understanding between Yuba County and the City of Marysville, and authorize Chair to execute.

### *Recommendation:*

Administrative Services' staff recommends the Board of Supervisors approve the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Yuba County and the City of Marysville to repave 14<sup>th</sup> Street, and authorize Chair to execute.

### *Background and Discussion:*

Yuba County has constructed the Tri-County Juvenile Rehabilitation Facility located at 938 14<sup>th</sup> Street in Marysville. The project consisted of a new stand-alone facility, single-story juvenile rehabilitation facility to house and provide treatment and program space for 32 male and female juveniles in two housing units on approximately 3 acres of vacant county owned land.

The County has been working with the City of Marysville to improve 14<sup>th</sup> Street. The existing roadway that fronts the new facility is in need of rehabilitation. County staff recommended that the City hire a contractor to repave and restripe the roadway. The City has went out to bid and has selected a contractor for the project. The attached MOU has been executed by the City. Yuba, Sutter and Colusa County's contribution to repave the roadway is \$120,000.

### *Committee Action:*

The Tri-County Juvenile Rehabilitation Oversight Committee recommends that this item be brought to the Board of Supervisors for approval.
