Recommendation

Administrative Services' staff recommends the Board of Supervisors approve the Resolution to support Operation Green Light declaring the week of November 6th through November 12th, 2023, a time to salute and honor the service of our men and women who served in the armed forces.

Background/Discussion

The National Association of Counties (NACo) and the National Association of County Veteran Service Officers (NACVSO) are inviting the nation's 3,069 counties, parishes and boroughs to join Operation Green Light and show support for veterans by lighting our buildings green during the week of Veterans Day, November 6th to November 12th.

Yuba County appreciates the sacrifices of our United States Military Personnel and would like to participate in the special recognition of Operation Green Light and encourage our citizens to recognize the importance of honoring all those who made the immeasurable sacrifices by displaying a green light in a window of their place of business or residence. Yuba County will be lighting green the Government Center, Packard Facility, and the Courthouse to show support.
