SUBJECT: Approve Amendment Number 1 with NV5 for the Medical and Mental Health Facility, and authorize Chair to execute

Recommendation:

Administrative Services' staff recommends the Board of Supervisors approve Amendment Number 1 with NV5 for quality assurance services for the Medical and Mental Health Facility, and authorize the Chair to execute.

Background & Discussion:

Yuba County is constructing the Medical and Mental Health Facility adjacent to the current Jail/Courthouse structure located at 215 5th Street in Marysville. This project consists of designing and constructing a new stand-alone jail facility on county-owned land. The new building will provide special use housing, medical and mental health treatment, and a secure corridor to the existing jail and support services.

NV5 has been providing quality assurance services for this project since 2022. The original contract term began September 2022 and is set to end in December of 2023. Due to unforeseen delays the current contract needs to be amended to match the extended project timeline to ensure NV5's services continue to the end of December 2024, the new proposed construction completion date.

Staff recommends the Board approve Amendment Number 1 and authorize Chair to execute.
