SUBJECT: Approve agreement with Tec-Com Low Voltage Solutions, Inc. for surveillance system upgrades, and authorize Chair to execute.

Recommendation:

Administrative Services' staff recommends the Board of Supervisors approve the agreement with Tec-Com Low Voltage Solutions, Inc. (Tec-Com) for surveillance upgrades at four (4) Marysville Joint Unified School District (MJUSD) campuses, and authorize Chair to execute.

Background and Discussion:

The Sheriff's Department was awarded a grant for the COPS 2020 School Violence Prevention Program (SVPP). The funds will be used to procure and install cameras on four (4) MJUSD campuses, Ella Elementary, Yuba Gardens Intermediate, Marysville High School and Lindhurst High School. The Sheriff will also have access to the cameras remotely on an as needed basis.

Administrative Services went out to Request for Proposals in August 2023. There were three (3) proposals received and Tec-Com was best value to the County. Staff recommends the Board approve the agreement with Tec-Com in the amount of \$337,860.00.
