SUBJECT: Approve Amendment No. 3 to the Agreement with R.E.Y. Engineers, Inc. for the Feather River Blvd. State of Good Repair Project (Contract No. 102-2256.1), and authorize Chair to execute.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Public Works recommends that the Board of Supervisors approve Amendment No. 3 to the Agreement with R.E.Y. Engineers, Inc. for the Feather River Blvd State of Good Repair Project, and authorize the Chair to execute.

BACKGROUND

Yuba County Department of Public Works plans to construct road rehabilitation, sidewalk improvements, Class II bicycle lanes, crosswalks, storm drains, striping, signage, curbs, gutters, ADA compliant ramps, LED streetlights, transit stop shelters along Feather River Blvd between Garden Ave and Alicia Ave. In 2020, an RFP was advertised seeking proposals for surveying and engineering services which included environmental services, a technical memorandum for biological resources, topographic survey and base map for the project corridor including all ground surveys, record data search and right-of-way map, roadway design including plans, specifications, & estimates (PS&E) at 65%, 95% and final design, and any additional tasks required to successfully complete the project. Three consultants submitted proposals for this project, and R.E.Y. Engineers, Inc. was selected as the top ranked consultant and awarded the contract for surveying and engineering services on June 23, 2020. Staff anticipates project completion by the end of the 2024 construction season.

DISCUSSION

Amendment No. 3 to the Agreement with R.E.Y Engineers, Inc. will address various design changes that have developed along the course of the Feather River Blvd State of Good Repair Project. Amendment #3 will increase compensation for the Agreement by \$125,000, raising the total not-to-exceed amount from \$253,484.00 to \$378,484.00. The total amendment value will be applied to project management and roadway design budgets and will create a new \$32,000 budget for bid period and construction support services.

COMMITTEE ACTION

The Land Use and Public Works Committee was bypassed as this project is budgeted.
