SUBJECT: Adopt resolution authorizing Director of Public Works to execute and submit all necessary documents relating to the Clean California Local Grant Program.

RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt resolution authorizing the Director of Public Works to execute agreements with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for the Clean California Local Grant Program (CCLGP) and delegating the authority to the Director of Public Works, or designee, to conduct all negotiations, sign and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, and payment requests, which may be necessary for the completion of the grant scope(s).

BACKGROUND:

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) developed the Clean California Local Grant Program (CCLGP) through which funds will go to local communities to beautify and improve local streets and roads, tribal lands, parks, pathways, and transit centers. Through the combination of adding beautification measures and art in public spaces along with the removal of litter and debris, this effort will enhance communities and improve spaces for walking and recreation.

In April 2023, Yuba County Public Works submitted an application for grant funding under the CCLGP to complete the Friendship Park Beautification Project. This project will develop and beautify Friendship Park by adding parking, lights, extensive landscaping, a new BMX track, new pickle-ball courts, two pavilion areas with picnic tables and barbeques, new playground areas, 6,000 linear-feet of accessible walkway/bike paths, new shade structures and benches along the walkway/bike path, rehabilitating the basketball court and skate park area, decorative fencing, and informational kiosks on local culture, wildlife, and plants.

In October 2023, Yuba County received notification that the Friendship Park Beautification Project was selected for CCLGP funding award.

This project is also funded in part by the Urban Greening Grant Program (UGGP) through the Natural Resource Agency.

DISCUSSION:

Public Works is presenting the Restricted Grant Agreement to fund the Friendship Park Beautification Project, under the CCLGP through Caltrans, to the Board of Supervisors for their review. An agreement is already in place for the additional funding through the UGGP. Once this agreement is in place, staff may begin executing work on this project that is billable to the CCLGP funding.

The resolution does two things: one, it authorizes the Director of Public Works to execute this agreement, and two, it delegates authority to the Director of Public Works to, in general, conduct and direct all business associated with this grant on this project.

COMMITTEE ACTION:

This item is being presented directly to the Board due to the urgent need to have this Restricted Grant Agreement in place. A consultant for design on this project has already been awarded an agreement. To stay on track with the CCLGP timelines, design must be complete within 2024, and construction must be complete near the end of 2025. Work, including design, that is intended to be billed to this grant cannot be performed until the Restricted Grant Agreement is in place.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The cost of the Friendship Park Beautification Project is \$5,930,600.00. Funding will be from a combination of sources: the CCLGP, the UGGP, and local funds.
