SUBJECT: Approve release of request for proposals for Infectious Disease and Emergency Response Project, and authorize Administrative Services to distribute.

Recommendation:

Administrative Services' staff recommends the Board of Supervisors approve the release of Request for Proposals (RFP) for Yuba County Health and Human Services Infectious Disease and Emergency Response Project, and authorize Administrative Services to distribute.

Background & Discussion:

Yuba County Health and Human Services Department (HHSD) is looking to develop eight (8) infectious disease control and response plans for two (2) local non-profit agencies operating three (3) congregate settings focusing on people experiencing homelessness, one (1) Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF), two (2) Residential Care Facilities for the Elderly (RCFE), and two (2) Assisted Living Facilities (ALF).

The COVID-19 pandemic has highlighted the need for local congregate settings to have preparedness and response plans in place for novel and established infectious diseases. Partnering with Yuba County Public Health and knowledgeable contractor will allow each of these facilities to have a robust plan which will take into consideration the unique needs and capabilities of the facilities, mitigation strategies, and response activities. The estimated cost for this project is \$200,000.
