RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Public Works recommends that the board of Supervisors accept Plumas Lake Phase 6 TM 2020-0006 as complete, release the Security Bonds, and authorize the Director of Public Works to file and record a Notice of Completion.

BACKGROUND:

KB Home was the developer that entered into the Subdivision Improvement Agreement for Plumas Lake Phase 6 Subdivision. The project consisted of constructing street improvements such as paved roadways, storm drain, curb, gutter, sidewalk, and streetlights for tract homes east of River Oaks Blvd, south of Minories Drive, north of Gila Ct., and west of Rio Grande Drive.

DISCUSSION:

The developer has completed the improvements. Per County Ordinance, the Board of Supervisors has the authority to release the bonds. Once the Board takes action to release the bonds, the Public Works Department will file a notice of completion and return the Security Bonds.

COMMITTEE ACTION:

The Land Use & Public Works Committee was bypassed due to the routine nature of this request.
