**SUBJECT:** County Clerk/Recorder/Registrar of Voters: Adopt resolution appointing special district directors in lieu of election for the November 5, 2024 General Election.

### *Recommendation*

Adopt resolution appointing special district directors in lieu of election for the November 5, 2024 General Election pursuant to Elections Code §10515.

### *Background*

The Board of Supervisors is required to make appointments when on the 83<sup>rd</sup> day prior to the District Election:

1. A petition signed by 10 percent of the voters or 50 voters, whichever is the smaller number in the district or division if elected by division, requesting that the general district election be held has not been presented; and
2. Only one person has filed a declaration of candidacy for nay elective office to be filled at that election, or
3. No one has filed a declaration of candidacy for such office, or
4. In the case of directors to be elected from the district at large, the number of persons who have filed a declaration of candidacy for director at large does not exceed the number of offices of director at large to be filled at the election, or
5. In the case of directors who must reside in a division but be elected at large, the number of candidates for director at large from a division does not exceed the number required to be elected at large while residing in that division.

### *Discussion*

A petition requesting the general district election be held, has not be presented.
