RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Public Works recommends the Board of Supervisors approve the plans, specifications, estimate, authorize the advertisement for bids for the Feather River Boulevard State of Good Repair Project, and authorize the Chair to execute.

BACKGROUND:

The County of Yuba was awarded a federal grant for design and construction funding for a capital improvement project on Feather River Blvd between Garden Ave and Alicia Ave. Yuba County Department of Public Works plans to construct sidewalk improvements, Class II bicycle lanes, crosswalks, storm drains, striping, signage, curbs, gutters, ADA compliant ramps, LED streetlights, and transit stop shelters along this stretch of Feather River Blvd. R.E.Y. Engineers, Inc. was selected as the top ranked consultant after an RFP and awarded the contract for surveying and engineering services on June 23, 2020.

DISCUSSION:

The work in general consists of sidewalk improvements, Class II bicycle lanes, crosswalks, storm drains, striping, signage, curbs, gutters, ADA compliant ramps, LED streetlights, and transit stop shelters along Feather River Boulevard in the community of West Linda. The design is complete and ready to advertise for construction bids. Public Works anticipates the advertisement for bids in October 2024, and construction is tentatively scheduled for March 2025.

COMMITTEE ACTION:

This item is being presented to the full Board of Supervisors as it is included within the approved County Budget.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Board Approved FY 2024-25 Budget Appropriation. Once the project is bid, the department will come back to the Board of Supervisors to award the construction contract. The project has an estimated cost of \$3,500,000.00.
