RECOMMENDATION:

The Department of Public Works recommends that the Board of Supervisors award the contract to the apparent low, responsive, and responsible bidder, Lamon Construction Company, Inc., for the Loma Rica Road Culvert Replacement Project, and authorize Chair to execute upon review and approval of County Counsel and Risk Management.

BACKGROUND:

Public Works has identified 11 culvert crossings on Loma Rica Road that need replacement. The section of Loma Rica Rd is between State Route 20 and Fruitland Road. The goal is to replace and/or rehabilitate these culverts before the future Loma Rica Road paving project.

DISCUSSION:

The Department of Public Works posted the solicitation for bids on September 18, 2024. Bids were received and opened by staff on October 10, 2024. The three lowest bids were received as shown:

Lamon Construction Company, Inc. was the apparent low, responsive, and responsible bidder with a bid total of \$395,165.00.
