Recommendation

Approve agreement with Adventist Health and Rideout for the Enrollment Specialist position for the term of March 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026.

Background

Medi-Cal members have access to services that go beyond the doctor's office or hospital and addresses all physical and mental health needs. HHS has partnered with the local hospital to assist community members with applying for programs such as Medi-Cal, CalFresh, and CalWORKs. Since the program began in June 2024, the embedded Enrollment Specialist has received approximately 700 referrals, submitted over 100 applications, and restored medical coverage for over 230 individuals.

The purpose of this Agreement is to continue to provide assistance to members of the community with applying for or restoring programs at time of need. These services include but are not limited to:

- Assist individuals to complete and submit applications for Medi-Cal, CalFresh and CalWORKs programs
- Assist individuals to complete redeterminations to keep Medi-Cal, CalFresh and CalWORKs benefits active
- Provide help with submitting required verification and documents
- Act as a liaison with HHSD

This partnership has allowed for HHSD and Adventist Health and Rideout to provide a more convenient way for community members to access HHS services directly at the hospital.
